

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

The Port Saint Lucie Amateur Radio Association will hold a special election at the Wednesday, February 27, 2019 General Membership Meeting to fill the position of vice president.

As was announced at last month's meeting, Charles Whipple, W4PHD, resigned as PSLARA President. Per the association bylaws, our Vice President, Jody Butte, W4SLD, assumed the position of President for the remainder of 2019. This leaves a vacancy in the vice president position, which will be filled by a special election at the February meeting.

The board has nominated Bob, KJ4UXS, for the vice president position. A call for additional nominations will be made at the meeting prior to the vote. Any member in good standing may nominate someone for the vice president position. Members may also nominate themselves for the position.

From the association's bylaws:

Qualification for PSLARA Officer and Director:

Any member of PSLARA who has been a member in good standing during a six month period preceding annual meeting for the election of officers and directors may be nominated for the positions of Director, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Should Bob or any other director be elected to serve as vice president, then the position that director currently holds will become vacant and an immediate special election will be held to fill that position. Nominations for this position will be taken from the floor prior to a vote.
